A yearly inspection and tune up for your home's plumbing system can reduce the number of repair calls for emergencies and maintenance. The annual plumbing inspection will consist of the following:

- 1. Inspect all visible drainage and water piping for leaks and corrosion.
- 2. Inspect faucets for leaks and proper operation.
- 3. Check all aerators and showerheads for leakage and debris.
- 4. Inspect tub and shower drains.
- 5. Inspect tub and shower area for leakage.
- 6. Inspect toilets for proper attachment and operation. Dye test toilets for leakage.
- 7. Inspect garbage disposer and kitchen sink drainage.
- 8. Inspect sink traps and drains for leakage and corrosion.
- 9. Inspect condition of washing machine hoses.
- 10. Check water system pressure to verify it is within operational limits.
- 11. Check the operation of the pump and pressure tank.
- 12. Check all outside faucets.
- 13. Test sink and toilet shut off valves.
- 14. Identify, test and tag the main water shut off. **Frequently old main house shut off valves break when opened or closed and must be replaced. It is better to know if a shut off valve is defective before it is needed in a crisis moment.

15 Provide a written report and estimates if any repairs are recommended.
